We provide age-specific activities and programs designed to help kids feel loved and welcomed in a safe environment.



A SWEET TREAT AND AN OBJECT LESSON FROM UL LUNA! ENJOY THE SURPRISE ON YOUR KIDS' FACES WHEN THE ROLL THEY HAD HID A MARSHMALLOW IN IS CHIPTY AFTER IT IS BAKED!

What you'll need

- 1(10-ounce) can refrigerated crescent dinner rolls
- 8 large marshmallows
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- · 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- ¼ cup sugar

What to do

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line a baking sheet with a parchment or silicone liner.
- 2. Open the crescent roll package and separate the rolls into eight triangles.
- 3. In a small bowl, whisk together the cinnamon and sugar.
- 4. Dip each of the marshmallows in the melted butter, then roll in the cinnamon sugar mixture.
- 5. Place a marshmallow in the middle of each dough triangle, then roll the dough tightly around the marshmallow, pinching to close all of the seams.
- 6. Place the rolls on the prepared baking sheet. Bake for 10-14 minutes, or until golden brown.

- As you roll the marshmallow in the cinnamon sugar mixture and wrap the dough around it, discuss how Jesus' friends would have prepared his body with spices and wrapped him in linens.
- While the rolls are baking, talk about how Jesus' friends waited not knowing what would happen, what must that have been like?
- When they open their roll, and the marshmallow is gone, remind them of the truth and good news of the empty tomb!




