MOTHER'S MORNING OUT CHANGES ITS NAME

Our 30-year Mother's Morning Out program has changed its name to **First Pres Nursery School** as of January 1. Director Beth Plyler stated, "Over the past several years we have seen changes in what the families in the community need for their children. We have truly become a part-time childcare option that serves both working and non-working parents in our church and community. We are confident our new name fully encompasses our program and what we are offering to families in Greenville."

First Pres Nursery School (FPNS) is a registered program that serves families of children ages three months through two years on weekdays from 9:00am to 2:00pm. FPNS provides opportunities for children to grow spiritually, socially, and developmentally through play activities in a Christian environment. The school runs August through May with an optional Summer Camp program in June and July. Registration is held each February for the upcoming school year. Summer Camp registration opens each January and serves children ages three months to rising K5. All families are welcome to register through the website portal: firstpres.campmanagement.com/enroll.
