# Transforming the Heart of the City

Thank You to everyone who has committed to the Capital Campaign toward our campus development.

On Easter 2019, we announced that we had received 453 commitments for \$15,477,325. We currently have commitments from 668 families and individuals for a total of \$17,929,504. Of this, \$7,782,767 has been received to date.

We are now working closely with contractors to formalize the details involved in construction, and have narrowed the field from five to three.

Demolition of the Symmes-Wilson building is planned for late June to early July. Construction is expected to begin in late August or early September.
