We've been given Christ's Commission (MATTHEW 28:18-20). Christ is praying for us (JOHN 17:20).

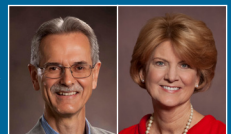
Now what? What do we do and how do we do it? These are the questions we will explore in the coming weeks.
