AN EVENING WITH C. S. LEWIS MAY 6

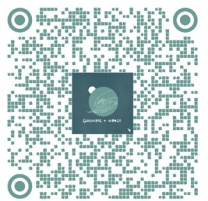

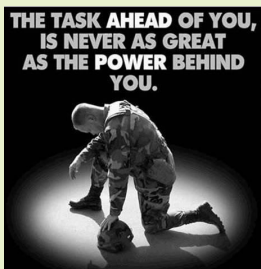
