LIFE CONNECTIONS SERIES: MEET OUR LEADERS

In this series we are highlighting leaders of some of our discipleship groups. This week we are delighted to introduce Tom Angermeier, president of the Flock Sunday Life Group.

"My wife Paula and I have been members of First Pres since 2006. Our three children have been involved in various youth activities and sports. Our two boys are Clemson graduates, and our daughter has just finished her junior year there, spending part of her last semester quarantined with us. Go Tigers!



I have been involved for several years with the Hollis Academy Backpack Program, which provides take-home bags of nutritious food to cover children's weekend meals. It is difficult to fathom, but for most of the students at Hollis, the only meals they can count on are school breakfasts and lunches. Through this program, FPC reflects the love and care of Christ to these anxious families.

I also help lead the Flock Sunday Life Group. Formed back in the 1980s primarily as a group of newlyweds, the Flock has evolved over the years and now includes both singles and marrieds in our late 40s to 60s. Most of us are still working, but we have a few retirees, too. We offer two- to four-week teaching series that present a biblical viewpoint on a wide variety of topics, ranging from caring for aging parents to living out our faith in our daily lives to deepening our own relationship with Christ. Throughout the year we gather for mission outreach and an occasional social event.

The Flock is a welcoming group. Many of us have aging parents, adult children in other cities, and young grandchildren, so our class size can range from 20 to 50 each Sunday.
