#### FURTHER UP & FURTHER IN: MERE CHRISTIANITY



Sanctuary Choir (Adult, College, High School)

Singers from beginners to seasoned professionals rehearse and lead worship through a variety of musical styles at 8:30am and 11:00am Sunday worship services.
