## TAX TIP FOR CHARITABLE GIVING WITH AN IRA

Starting at age 72, the IRS mandates that IRA owners take annual income withdrawals, known as Required Minimum Distributions or RMDs, from their account. If you are in the situation of having to take an RMD and are also giving to the First Pres operating budget or Capital Campaign, you may want to talk with your tax advisor to see if giving all or a portion of your RMD to the church will be beneficial for you from a tax standpoint. If the answer is yes, you can talk with your IRA administrator about sending the amount you desire directly from your RMD to First Presbyterian Church.

You and the church will both benefit from this transaction: you will not have to report the amount given directly to the church as earned income on your tax return, and the church receives a nice donation for the operating budget, Capital Campaign, or Foundation.
