TAX TIP FOR CHARITABLE GIVING WITH AN IRA

If you take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your IRA account, and are also giving to the First Pres operating budget, Capital Campaign, or Foundation, you may want to talk with your tax advisor to see if giving all or a portion of your RMD to the church will be beneficial for you from a tax standpoint.
