EXCITING CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



The chiller that provides cooling for the Sanctuary, Gym, and many of the classrooms on that side of our campus, currently located in the Symmes-Wilson building, has far exceeded its

useful life, having last been replaced over 30 years ago. To ensure that we will have cooling for our facilities by spring, a new chiller will be installed during the early winter. This new chiller will eventually be mounted on the new Worship & Arts Center and Gym, but must be placed in a temporary location during construction.

You will soon see construction in the alley between the Symmes-Wilson building and the Sanctuary, where the new chiller will temporarily reside. The alley will become one-way, entering from Washington Street, beginning in early January, and the handicap parking spots will be angled to enable easier parking. Please help us to ensure a safe transition by following the new directional signs. Let's celebrate the beginning of Transforming the Heart of the City!
